

## Make fast work of lightweight cutting.

The light-duty KS-221 panel saw cuts plastic and other soft rigid materials up to 1/4" thick; aluminum up to 1/8"; and mild steel to 18 gauge.

It's the ideal saw for cutting gutters, aluminum siding and autobody panels; and it's perfect for sign-making and model shop work.

Highly maneuverable, the KS-221 cuts fast and quiet, leaving a milled, ready-to-fabricate finish without burning the metal. Its rugged 4.5 amp, 120 volt motor is double-insulated and operates up to 2500 RPM.



## Safe, accurate plunge cuts.

Simply hold the tool in an upright position while you bring the saw-blade into perfect starting alignment. Only the blade guard comes in contact with the panel, so there's never a risk of marring the work-piece.

As you saw, the blade guard rides smoothly over the panel surface, letting you start and stop plunge cuts exactly where you want to. Use a back-stop to prevent backward movement, and when the cut is finished, the guard automatically drops down to cover the blade.
